If you are interested in joining Year 12, please indicate which subjects you wish to study from the list by **numbering them 1(top priority) to 4**. It would also be useful if you indicate a **fifth choice as a reserve (R)**. The majority of courses available are AS level however there are some BTec Level 3 programmes available which are equivalent to a single AS level.

In the box marked 'Other' you can indicate the title of a course that you would like to take, but which is not currently listed. We may be able to offer this course if we know about it in advance.
