

Key Stage 4 Choices 2010

This sheet gives a brief overview of the option choices you have this year as you move from Key Stage 3 into Key Stage 4 and beyond. You will receive a more detailed booklet, which will give information about all the subjects you could study in Year 10, later this term and before the parents' option evening on Thursday 13 January. Parents' evening follows on Tuesday 8 February before final choices need to be made by Wednesday 16 February.

You will need to decide which route you will follow in Key Stage 4:

Route 1: All GCSEs

Route 2: Diploma plus some GCSEs

Route 3: College Course plus some GCSEs

All students will study the Core Curriculum of English, Mathematics, Science, Religious Education, Games and Space.

In addition:

Route 1 students will choose a further 3 GCSEs plus a Technology subject.

Route 2 students will study a diploma (Level 2) plus 1 more GCSE.

Route 3 students will choose from a variety of Foundation Learning/College courses at Level 1 plus 1 more GCSE.

The GCSE/Btec choices are:

- Art and Design
- Business
- Drama
- French
- German
- Geography
- History
- ICT (Btec)
- Music (Btec)
- Physical Education
- Personal and Social Development (PSD)
- Separate Science

The Technology choices are:

- Electronic Products
- Graphics Products
- Food
- Art and Design

The Diploma Choices are:

- **Engineering** (BGS and East Riding College)
- **Creative and Media** (Longcroft and Market Weighton)
- **Manufacturing and Product Design** (BHS)
- **Society, Health and Development** (East Riding College and Beverley High School)
- **Hair and Beauty** (East Riding College)
- **Environment and Land Based Studies** (Bishop Burton College)

The Foundation Learning/College Choices will be decided in consultation with individual students. It will probably include Motor Vehicles, Hospitality and Public Services.
